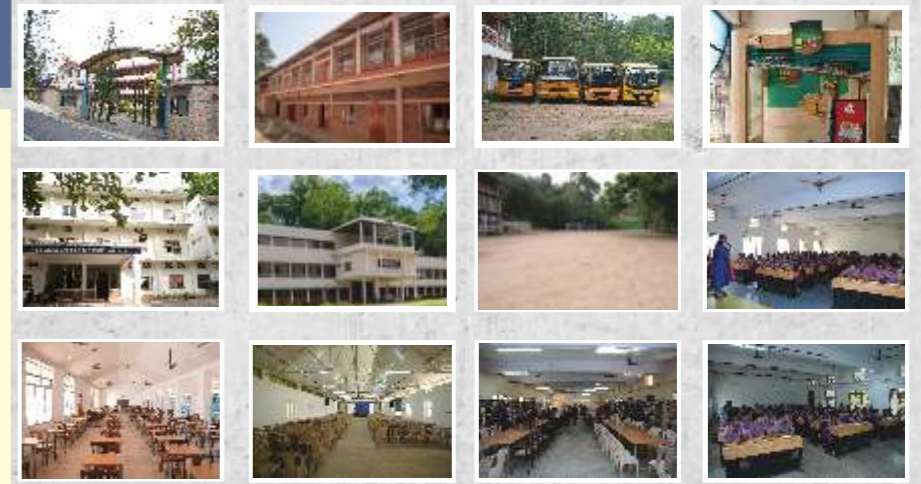
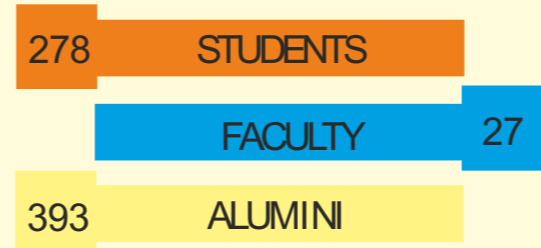







**World Mental Health Day**
